When the owners of this lovely home decided it was time to renovate, coming up with a theme was simple: provincial. Suited to their homely and welcoming style of entertaining, the classic style of the kitchen draws you like a magnet to its charm.

Working closely with designer Erika Forster of Kitcheners Kitchens, the entire cooking area has been customised, ensuring many special features which fit seamlessly together to create a zone perfectly in tune with the owners' wants and needs. For example, there's the integrated fridge that runs straight into the benchtop and stove. There's also the rangehood with detail capping and corbels.

The length of the kitchen leads you to a bright, sunny courtyard that boasts bi-folding doors to encourage an indoor-outdoor lifestyle. These doors also allow plenty of light to stream in, catching on the reflective granite benchtop. A colour palette was chosen to complement the existing materials, such as the slate floors and exposed brickwork.

One of the most interesting features of this kitchen is the Perrin and Rowe tap. The owner, Richard Fry, bought the tap on a visit to the UK, which subsequently resulted in a round-the-world trip after leaving London and stopping in Paris, Switzerland, Tel-Aviv, Bangkok and, finally, arriving in Sydney; airport security checked it out as hand luggage at each stop. The tap set the theme for other items in the kitchen, such as the handles.
